

Health Insurance Appointment 1 April

All of you, who registered with the AOK public health insurance, have to go to AOK's office (address on the right).

You need to bring with you:

- Immatrikulationsbescheinigung (Confirmation of enrollment) – you will get it when arrive in Hamburg
- copy of your address registration - you will get it when arrive in Hamburg
- ID/Passport
- Bank details for the monthly fee
