We are pleased to invite you to the **second edition of the GreenGardens Webinar Series**, a series of free online events exploring approaches to climate change adaptation in agriculture and agroforestry.

The Shared Gardens for Climate Change Adaptation (Jardins adaptés au climat) Project, led by Université de Moncton (Canada), brings together over 200 farmers and 20 researchers from academic institutions in Canada, Germany, Morocco, and Benin. Using design thinking, a participatory approach centered on farmers' needs, the cooperatives engaged in the project will share their vulnerabilities, the measures already taken to protect their land and the climate change adaptations implemented.

This second edition, taking place on **September 30, 2025**, will focus on the **Impacts of climate change on health and well-being of women farmers.** The event will be held in English, and will provide a space for exchange between practitioners, researchers, teaching staff, and members of local cooperatives involved in the project.
