FAQs

Application and Admission

When do I apply?

The application period is October 1 – November 30 for starting in the subsequent summer semester (April). There is no intake of new first semester students in the winter semester.

What documents do I need to apply?

- If you did not complete your secondary education in Germany, you need a VPD from uni assist (https://www.uni-assist.de/en/how-to-apply/plan-your-application/vpd/)
- Proof of English language proficiency level B2 (https://www.haw-hamburg.de/fileadmin/Studium/Studierendensekretariat/PDF/EnglischB2_Auszug_HAW-AZO_English.pdf)
- Identity Card

To strengthen your application, you can upload any document that you feel sheds a positive light on you.

Can I use a VPD issued for another university?

Unfortunately, we need a VPD issued explicitly for HAW Hamburg.

Do I need German language proficiency for the program?

There is no need to have any German language knowledge to apply.

What is the GPA requirement?

We do not have a NC / GPA requirement. What grade is good enough to be accepted depends both on the other applicants as well as on the other application documents you upload. In the Admissions and Selection Regulations (https://www.haw-

grade as stated in the "VPD".

Is the program restricted?

Yes, it is. After the deadline the commission committee makes a ranking and determines who

will get a spot.

When will I know if I get accepted?

Admission letters go out approximately two weeks after the application deadline.

When I have been admitted, is deferral or late arrival possible?

Yes, it is. Please contact us for further information.

Fees and financing

Do I need to pay tuition?

We do not charge tuition fees. It is only necessary to pay the so-called semester contribution which is currently 379 euros per semester. Living costs in Hamburg will be around 800 - 1000

euros per month.

Do you offer scholarships?

For applying to HAW scholarships you first have to start your studies. From the third semester onwards you can apply, provided you have (very) good academic achievements:

There are 25 student accommodations available, at different places throughout the city, one also very close to the campus (Gustav-Radbruch-Haus: STW Hamburg (stwhh.de); however, there are never enough places for all applicants and the waiting lists are long, so probably you might have to look for something by yourself.
